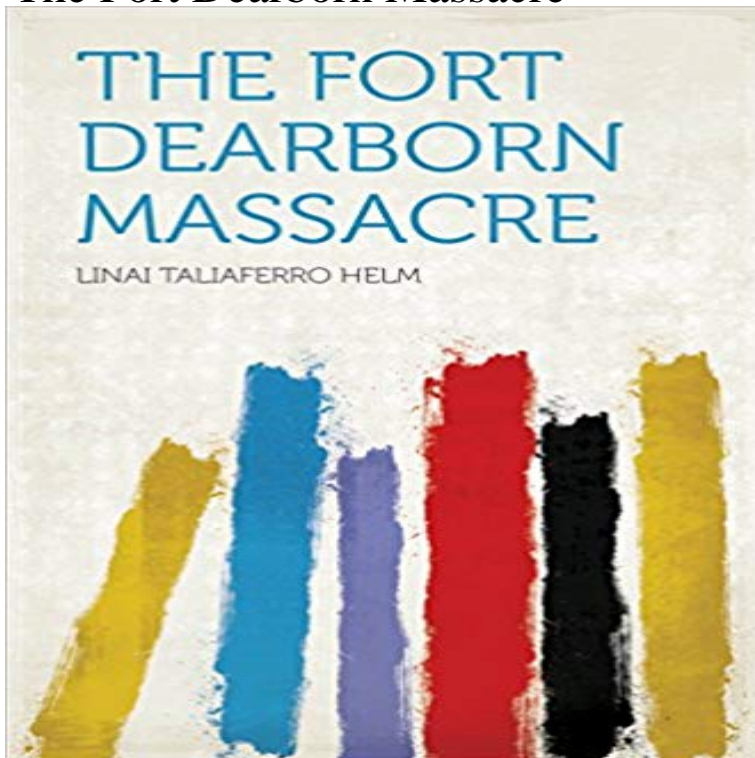


The Fort Dearborn Massacre
