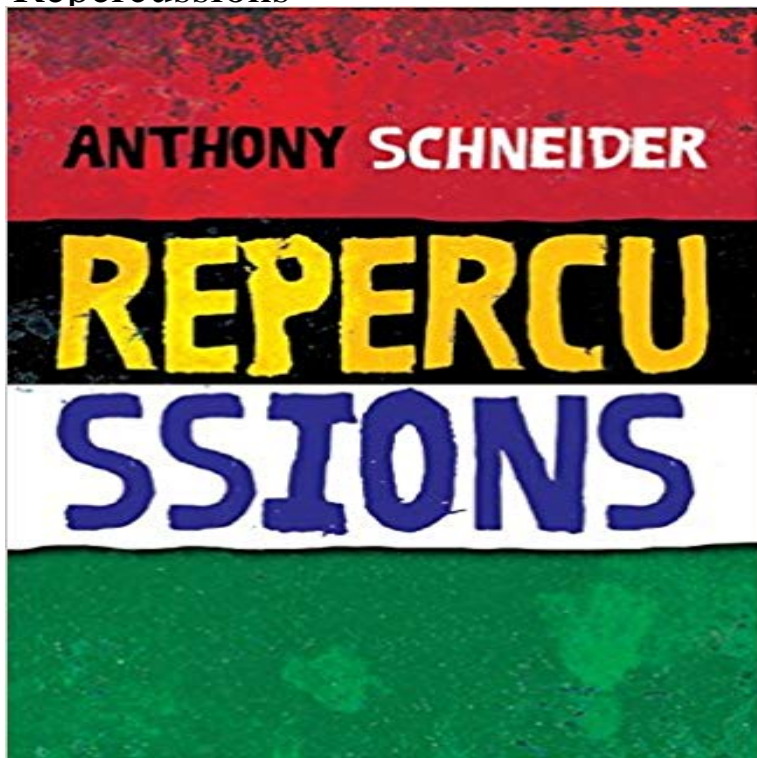


Repercussions
